
Congratulations on purchasing your new RCA player.

Please read these instructions for quick tips on using the player.




Getting Started

. The battery should be fully charged before using your device for the first time. Use the supplied USB connector cable to connect it to your computer or other USB power source. It should be charged for at least 4 hours before using for the first time.



Transfer audio/video/photo/text files to the MUSIC, VIDEO, PHOTO or EBOOK folders of the player by dragging and dropping files using Windows Explorer.

3. In the Windows system tray, click **Safely Remove Hardware** icon ^{So} and select the device with the appropriate driver letter from the list of devices. Disconnect the player from the computer and enjoy media on the go.



4. Video files must be converted by RCA AMV Converter for playback on your player. To install RCA AMV Converter, go to My Computer (XP users) /Go to Computer (Vista, 7, and 8 users) in the Start menu find and open the drive letter associated with the player (i.e. RCA MP3) and then double-click the RCA AMVConverter setup.exe file to launch the installer

For detailed explanation on using RCA AMV Converter, open the RCA AMV Converter software and click

the Help module _____ on the main screen.

Note: Audio, video, photo and text files must be transferred to their respective folders on the player to ensure proper detection and playback.

Inserting (or removing) memory card

This player has a memory card slot for reading data from a microSD memory card (not included).

To insert card: Push the card in until a click is heard.

To remove card: Push card in until a click is heard, then slowly release the card. As card is under minimal tension when locked in memory slot, please use care when removing. As the memory card is small in size, it is recommended to use a small coin to help insert or remove it.

Start or pause recording	In the Home menu, press I wor I to select Record and then press M to confirm your selection. In the Record mode, press ▶ II to start or pause recording. To save the recording, press and hold ▶ II.
Playback a voice recording	In the Home menu, press i or i bit o select Voice. In the Voice mode, press i or i bit o select the desired recording, and press i l to begin playback.
Reset the player (if it is not responding)	Slide the ON/OFF switch to OFF. Slide the ON/OFF switch to ON to reset the player.
