ACABSC2 - Blind Spot Camera Installation Guide

Installation Information

PROFESSIONAL INSTALLTION IS RECOMMENDED.

This camera is designed to be mounted on the vehicle. Find a location that will not obstruct any equipment on your vehicle and will allow you to safely route the power/video cable into the vehicle. Use caution to not block or obstruct airbags or any safety device.

All connections should be made inside the vehicle as the power and video connections are not waterproof.

Always check twice before drilling a hole or screwing into something to insure there is nothing behind that surface.

Connect the video output (yellow) connection to the included extension cable and route the cable to the front of the vehicle. Connect this to your monitor's rear view camera input.

Wipe clean and Dry the mounting surface for two-way tape. Adjust the camera angle/direction to optimize your view on your monitor and firmly mount Camera with two-way tape.

When using the 'flush mount' method - always double check to make sure you do not hit anything behind your mounting surface. The drill bit included is designed for plastic bumpers and trim panels. If you will be mounting this in Metal you will need a metal hold saw (NOT INCUDED). Use a 16.5 mm metal cutting hold saw if needed. It is always a good idea to cover or protect the area around your mounting location with masking tape before drilling.

Alternate Applications

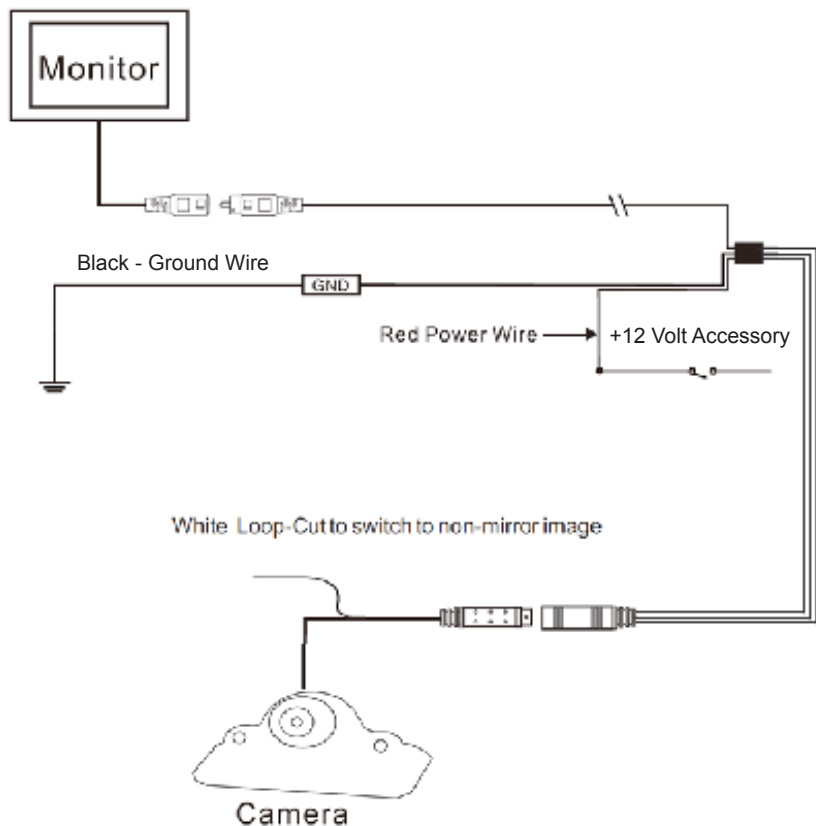
The ACABSC2 Blind Stop Camera can be used for alternate applications and can be installed in various locations on the vehicle, such as:

Troubleshooting

Issue	Reason	Troubleshooting
Screen Shake	Loose mount	Adjust camera's mount to secure location
No Image	Cables connection compromised	Unplug all connections and check for debris/foreign objects. Clean/clear connection and plug in cables
Blurry Screen	Camera lens is dirty	Carefully clean camera lens
Inclined Screen	Camera installed incorrectly	Adjust the camera's mount and placement
