## Charging

- Connect the supplied USB charging cable into the CHARGE jack on the bottom of the right headphone. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (like a computer or a USB charger).


## Charging

- The charging indicator next to the CHARGE jack turns red while the headphones are charging. When charging is complete, the Charging Indicator turns blue.
- Unplug the USB charging cable when the headphones are fully charged.

## Turning On/Off


Power On: Slide the **ON/OFF** switch on the bottom right of the headphone to the ON position.

Power Off: Slide the **ON/OFF** switch on the bottom right of the headphone to the OFF position.

	<b>Important:</b> The battery should be fully charged prior to first use. Whenever the battery is fully discharged, immediately recharge it (regardless of whether you plan to use the battery or not) in order to maximize battery life. If you plan not to use the battery for an extended period of time (one week or longer), we recommend that you fully charge the battery. For longer periods of storage, please recharge the battery at least once every two months to maintain the battery in optimal condition.

## Pairing

Pair the HPA88BKMBT with your phone/device to create an audio streaming link between the two devices. Your devices must be paired before music can be played.

	<b>Important<span> </span>:</b> Make sure that your phone/device supports Bluetooth A2DP* (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile) before proceeding. <i>*A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile) is a technology that enables streaming of stream stereo sound from an audio source (phone, PC, laptop, tablet, mp3 player) to a stereo speaker or headset via Bluetooth. To do so, both devices must support this profile.</i>

- If the headphone is off, slide the **ON/OFF** switch to ON.
- To enable pairing, press the **Ⓛ**

button on the side of the left headphone for 3 seconds until the **pairing indicator** on the top of the left headphone begins blinking rapidly. The HPA88BKMBT is now ready to pair.

**Note:** Before entering the pairing mode, the headphone will first try to reconnect with the last connected device. If trying to pair a new device ensure the previously connected device is out of range or that its bluetooth functions are turned off.

- While the HPA88BKMBT is in pairing mode, select 808 Headphone from the list of Bluetooth devices of your phone.
- If your phone asks for a password/ pin code, enter 0000 and press **OK**.
- Upon successful pairing, the HPA88BKMBT will beep once and

the **pairing indicator** on the top of the left headphone will turn solid blue. It is now ready to use with your phone.


## Reconnecting

- When you turn on the headphones press the **Ⓛ** button for 3 seconds to reconnect to the last connected device (if it is in range).
- If the last connected device is not available, the headphones will enter pairing mode and be ready to receive a connection.
- If the headphones go out of range and lose their connection for less than three minutes, they will automatically reconnect when back in range.
- If the headphones do not automatically reconnect, press the **Ⓛ** button to reconnect.

## Using the In-line Microphone Cable

### Controlling audio playback

- During audio playback, press the push-to-talk button on the supplied flat audio cable a single time to play or pause a track. Press twice quickly to go to the next track, or press three times to go the previous track.
- When there is an incoming phone call, press the push-to-talk button a single time to answer/end calls.

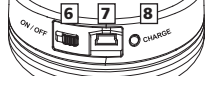

## Auxiliary source


- Plug one end of one of the supplied audio cables into the **AUX** jack on the bottom of the left headphone and the other end into the output of your music player. When using the supplied flat microphone cable, the L-shaped cabled end should be connect to the audio source, and the straight end should be connected to the headphone.
- Press "Play" on your music player to begin audio playback.
- For adjusting volume and controlling audio playback, please use the controls on your music player directly.

## Answering/ending phone calls
